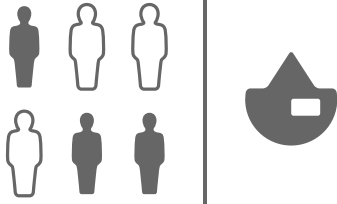


WHO NEEDS TO GET FITTED?



All employees required to wear tight-fitting respirators, including N95 filtering facepiece respirators, elastomerics, & tight-fitting PAPRs (with the blower off).



PAPRs with loose-fitting facepieces, hoods, or helmets, do not require fit testing.

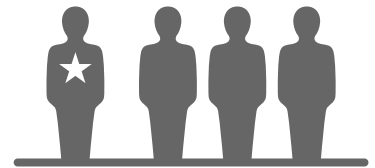
HOW TO GET FIT TESTED?



An OSHA-accepted fit test protocol must be followed exactly as written.



Fit testing may be done using a qualitative test using Bitrex® or saccharin or a quantitative test using a PortaCount® or another appropriate instrument.

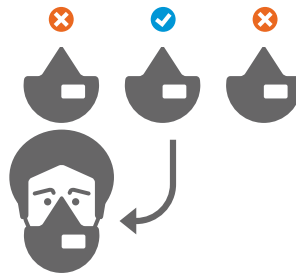


Fit tests must be performed by a qualified individual, able to follow the protocol & train employees.

FOLLOW UP



Records must be kept on file until the next annual test is performed.



Know fit tested size and model of respirator.



A fit test is required before a respirator can be worn, yearly, and after any physical changes that may affect the fit (weight gain/loss, dental work, etc.)
