Workers' Compensation Information

The Pennsylvania workers' compensation law provides wage loss and medical benefits to employees who cannot work, or who need medical care, because of a work-related injury.

Benefits are required to be paid by your employer when self-insured, or through insurance provided by your employer. Your employer is insured by **ICW Group P.O. Box 509039 San Diego, CA 92150, phone number 800.877.1111**. This information is to be posted at your company's primary place of business and its sites of employment in a prominent and easily accessible place, including, without limitation, areas used for the administration of first aid.

- You should report immediately any injury or work-related illness to your employer.
- Your benefits could be delayed or denied if you do not notify your employer immediately.
- If your claim is denied by your employer, you have the right to request a hearing before a workers' compensation judge.
