#### Cost of workplace accidents

#### Spells trouble for bottom line

\$3 trillion

The annual cost to the global economy from accidents and work-related diseases.





#### Cost of workplace accidents

## Accident Cost/Profit per unit = The number of Units required to Pay for this Claim

Assume a \$5,000 Accident cost for one injury

\$100 Unit sale price (20% profit margin = \$20 Profit per unit)

#### **Cost in Units**

• \$5,000 / \$20 = 250 Unit to pay accident costs of that claim

#### **Cost in Production hours**

If you produce 25 units per hours = 10 hours to pay for this Accident

















- Unsafe act
- Unsafe condition
- Combination of Both

One Root Cause

#### Investigate

- WHAT type of injury?
- Affecting what BODY PART?
- WHERE was worker positioned?
- HOW were they doing their job prior to injury?
- What caused ACCIDENT?



#### Investigate the scene

Fact Finding – Not Fault Finding

- Keep open mind
- Don't presume cause
- Interview witnesses
- Get the facts!
- Get to the Root Cause
- Keep asking "WHY?"





#### Investigate the scene

Record details – take photos!









### Investigate the scene

#### **Examples**:

- Guards off
- Lack of PPE
- Housekeeping issues
- Work practices
- Faulty equipment
- Lack of supervision or enforcement







#### **Avoid Investigation Pitfalls**

- Reluctance to accept responsibility
- Limited interpretation of environmental cause
- Erroneous emphasis on single cause
- Allow solution to determine cause



**ERROR!** 





#### **Accident Investigation Form**

- Complete after incident
- Detail thoroughly
- Supplement for claims reporting
- Identify factors causing incident
- Recommend corrections
















Root cause: common trend leading to conditions

- Company doesn't own a push block
- Employees not encouraged to observe & report
- General culture is to use regardless of missing safety guards, etc.



#### **Investigation Techniques**

- The 5 Why's
- Fishbone Analysis
- Event and Causal Factors Analysis
- Multilinear Events Sequencing
- Project Evaluation Tree
- Combination of above





#### **Root Cause Form**

- Dig deep to get to cause
  - Equipment
  - Environment
  - People
- Suggests corrective actions
- Add your plan













#### Report

- Complete forms
- Send ASAP to ICW Group
  - Phone (easiest!)
  - Email, Mail, Fax
- Create incident log for non-reportable incidents
- OSHA 300 log













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TO A SAFER WORKPLACE

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## Follow-up

- Did correction work?
- What is outcome?
  - More problems?
  - Solved?
- Continuously monitor (MORE – Observing, monitoring, etc.)



## Be ready when accidents happen

- Write clear policy statement
- Identify who notifies outside agencies
- Designate who investigates accidents
- Train accident investigators
- Establish investigation timetables
- Identify who receives report
- Take corrective action

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
